The heart is an incredibly strong muscle that acts as a pump: it is the central component of the cardiovascular system. The human heart, which is about the size of a clenched fist, is divided into four chambers: the left and right ventricles on the bottom and the left and the right atria on top. A valve helps to divide the upper and the lower chambers on each side and ensures that the blood flows in a forward direction. Another set of valves divides the right ventricle from the aorta, the main distributor of blood to the rest of the body.
